The BHGH Steward Scholar Opportunity

In addition to the BHGH Scholarship of \$3,000 per year college scholarship, which will be underwritten by the program, BHGH Steward Scholars will have access to the following opportunities.

- **STEM Networking Opportunity:** BHGH Steward Scholars will receive an all-expense paid opportunity to participate in a professional networking event organized by one of the member organizations of the Global Leadership Forum. The Global Leadership Forum (GLF) is designed to create, nurture and evolve a coalition of organizations whose collective missions will increase the number of competitive, diverse technologists in the talent pipeline who will lead the global marketplace. David Steward is a founding member of the GLF and a member of the GLF Advisory Board. BHGH Steward Scholars will have the opportunity to attend one of the following networking conferences.

- **Summer Internships:** Starting in 2018, BHGH Steward Scholars will have the opportunity to apply for paid summer internships at World Wide Technology (WWT) and WWT's partner companies. There is no guarantee of placement but BHGH Steward Scholars will have a preference in the application process.

Selection Criteria

- Applicants must be a BHGH Collegian in good standing.
- Applicants must be BHGH Collegians in their 1st, 2nd or 3rd years of study. For collegians with a standard 5 year major, 4th year students may apply.
- Applicants must have majors in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Business or the Arts.
- Applicants must have had a GPA of 3.0 or above during their previous semester of study. Applicants must demonstrate they are “people for others”—young people with a strong work ethic who can articulate their prosocial values and put them into practice through active service learning.

BHGH Steward Scholars who continue to meet the application requirements may continue to be selected as BHGH Steward Scholars for multiple years of their university education.

Application Process

Interested collegians must submit the following application information to stewardscholars@bhgh.org by **Monday, January 30th**.

- Please complete all components of the standard Boys Hope Girls scholarship application process.
- Please submit a short essay (maximum of 2 pages, 12 point font) that expresses: Please submit a short essay (maximum of 2 pages, 12 point font) explaining why you think you would be a good candidate for the BHGH Steward Scholarship, how this opportunity connects to your career goals and interests and the role that your character values will play as you go about your future career.
- Please submit one letter of recommendation that speaks to your work ethic and commitment to character development and community service (being a “person for others”). This recommendation can come from a BHGH Affiliate Leader who has worked with you or a contact through your university.
